- Joisted Masonry (JM) / Masonry Non-Combustible (MNC) construction within 1 mile of the coast must be built 1961 or newer
- Modified Fire Resistive (MFR) / Fire Resistive (FR) construction within 1/2 mile of the coast must be built 1961 or newer
- Tri county:
 - JM / MNC within 2 miles of the coast must be built 1981 or newer
 - MFR / FR within 1 mile of the coast must be built 1981 or newer
